Expect ceasefire uplift the SET

The SET is expected to climb after Trump accepted Pakistan's 2-week ceasefire proposal on condition the Strait of Hormuz is opened. Iran's agreement to a ceasefire has shifted sentiment to "risk-on." While falling oil prices will drag on upstream energy stocks, sectors previously burdened by high energy costs are poised to outperform. Technically, a break above 1490 could see the index target 1500.

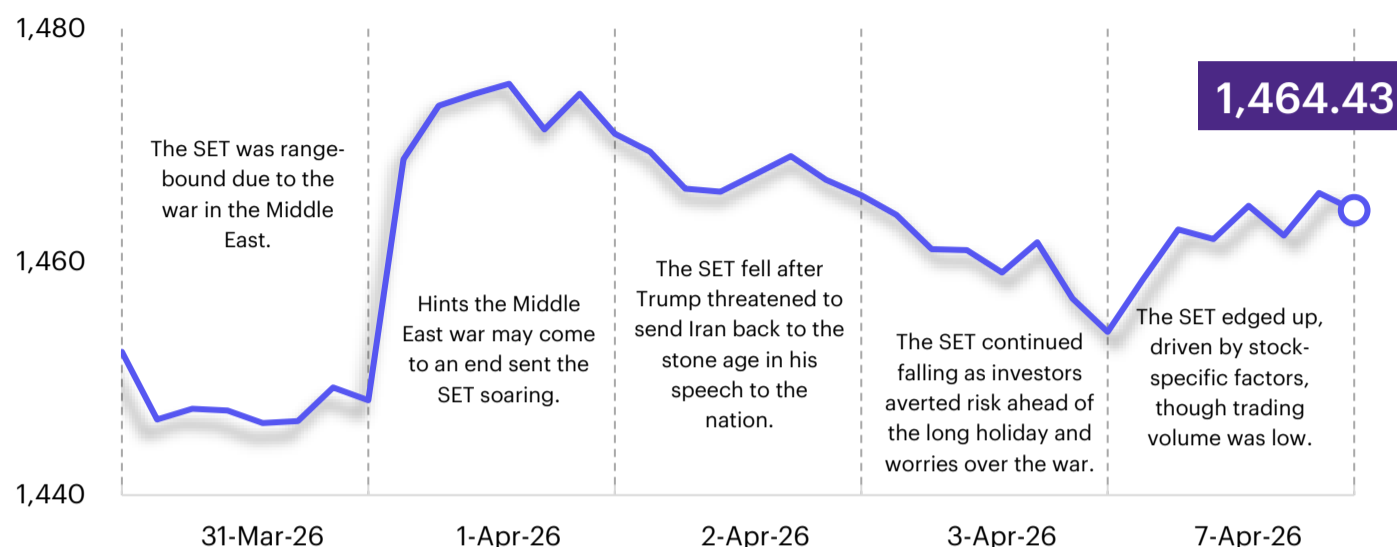
Today's highlights

- Trump has postponed strikes on Iran for two weeks after Tehran guaranteed safe passage through the Strait of Hormuz during the truce. Peace talks are set to begin in Pakistan. This "risk-on" breakthrough sent Brent crude down 14% to US\$93.5/bbl, a strong tailwind for energy-dependent stocks (airlines and SPP power plants).
- The Energy Minister announced an immediate Bt2.00/liter reduction in ex-refinery prices for Diesel B7 and B20 (lowering it from Bt17.50/liter). While the pump price adjustment awaits an official okay, this move is negative for refinery margins in the short term. Investors are advised to remain cautious regarding the refinery sector until government policy stabilizes.
- The Transport Minister reaffirmed the government's commitment to major infrastructure, targeting a 2028 phase 1 start for the landbridge project. Other priorities include developing the Chana Industrial Estate as a data center hub and pushing mixed-use projects in the EEC. Notably, the high-speed rail contract for three airports will not be revised. This is positive for Construction and Industrial Estates (STECOM, CK, AMATA, WHA).
- Thai inflation in March 2026 contracted 0.08% YoY, down for the 12th month. Despite geopolitical pressure, energy subsidies kept headline figures low. However, TPSO expects inflation to turn up in 2Q26 and has raised its 2026 forecast to 1.5%–2.5% (from 0%–1%).
- Foreign arrivals dropped 9.6%WoW to 569,593, led Malaysians who canceled trips due to fears of local fuel shortages. Arrivals from Russia, China, and India also softened, suggesting a temporary lull following the recent peak season.

Strategy today

In the near term, the SET is expected to remain highly volatile, with the Middle East war serving as the primary driver. Should negotiations yield a permanent peace agreement, the index could rally to test the 1500–1530 range, reflecting a return of investor confidence. Conversely, if talks break down or military confrontations escalate, the index is likely to face renewed selling pressure and retest its previous lows or fall further to the 1320–1350 range. Additionally, trading volumes on the SET may begin to thin toward the end of the week ahead of the extended Songkran holiday, which could amplify index volatility should any selling emerge. Our investment strategy is therefore categorized according to individual investor risk profiles.

Trading today

The SET remains volatile amid the evolving Middle East situation, requiring a flexible investment strategy tailored to investor risk tolerance and expectations, as follows:

- Low-risk investors who are concerned about failed negotiations are advised to hold cash or short-term fixed income to maintain liquidity and mitigate the impact of rising bond yields. This calls for patience until the situation clarifies and prices retrace for fundamentally strong assets. Simultaneously, hedge strategically to protect the portfolio with stocks benefiting from rising oil prices, such as PTTEP and PTTGC, while always setting trailing stops in case the situation begins to ease. Additionally, accumulate high-dividend stocks (dividend yield of >5%) to generate short-term cash flow ahead of XDs in April–May: KTB, KTC, KBANK, KKP, TISCO, BAM, AP, TLI.
- High-risk investors who are optimistic on negotiations are advised to adjust their portfolios based on the following timeframes and volatility:
 1. Short-term (1–4 weeks): Focus on tactical bounce trades in stocks poised to benefit from an oil price correction and supply chain recovery. This includes Airlines (AAV, THAI), SPP power plants (GPSC, BGRIM), Tourism (CENTEL, ERW, MINT), premium Healthcare (BH, BDMS), and Automotive (AH, SAT). Additionally, target SET50 stocks that have fallen more sharply than the broader index since the crisis and are positioned for short covering: BTS, LH, MINT, AWC, BDMS, HMPRO, OR, CPALL.
 2. Medium-term (3–6 months): Gradually accumulate defensive stocks with high pricing power to combat higher inflation driven by structurally higher oil prices: Telecom (ADVANC, TRUE), Healthcare (BDMS, BH, CHG, BCH), and Commerce (CPALL, CPAXT, BJC, CPN).
 3. Long-term (6–12 months+): Focus on clean energy and Industrial Estate stocks that align with the structural shift toward alternative energy: GULF, GPSC, BGRIM, GUNKUL, WHA, AMATA.

Trading idea — Summer play theme: Consumer spending is expected to rise along with soaring temperatures, led by: 1) Beverages — prioritizing stocks with predominantly domestic revenue to minimize external volatility: ICHI, HTC; and 2) Commerce — selecting stocks that benefit as key distribution channels for beverages and cooling products: CPALL, HMPRO, GLOBAL.

Daily Top Picks

MINT: Short-term catalyst from the temporary ceasefire between the US and Iran, which is expected to trigger short covering. Tourism outlook for Thailand and Europe remains positive. Earnings are projected to bottom out in 1Q26, while the setup of a REIT will strengthen the balance sheet and debt and interest expenses. Short-term TP is Bt22.50.

GPSC: Short-term catalyst from expectations of lower fuel costs following the ceasefire, supported by declining bond yields and a stronger baht. 2026 normalized profit is set to grow, driven by rising electricity demand from data centers and PTT Group's asset monetization plans. Short-term TP is Bt35.50.



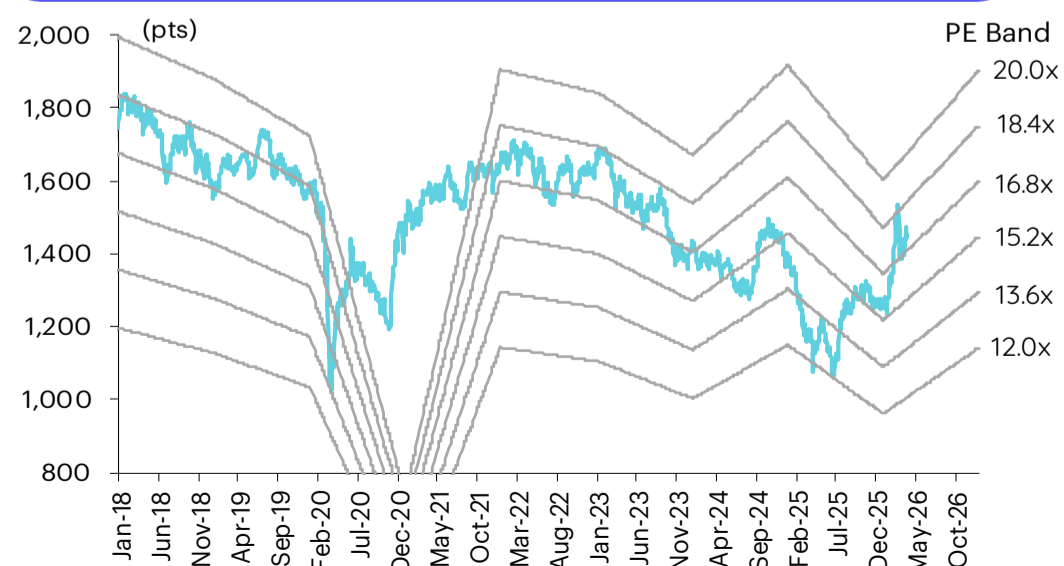

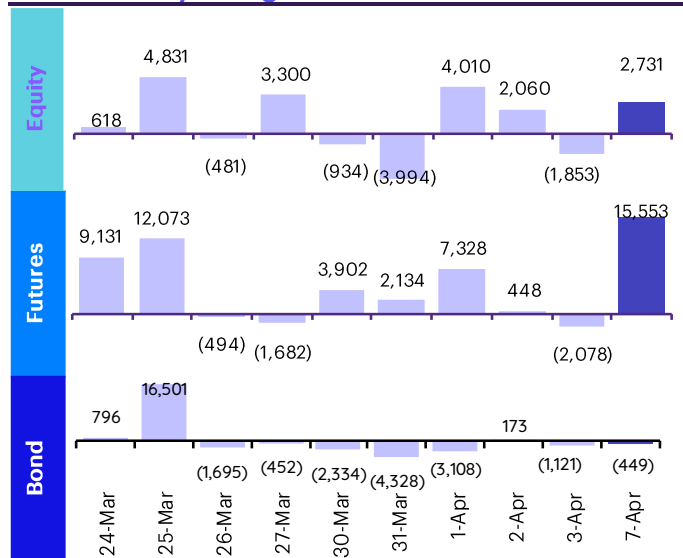

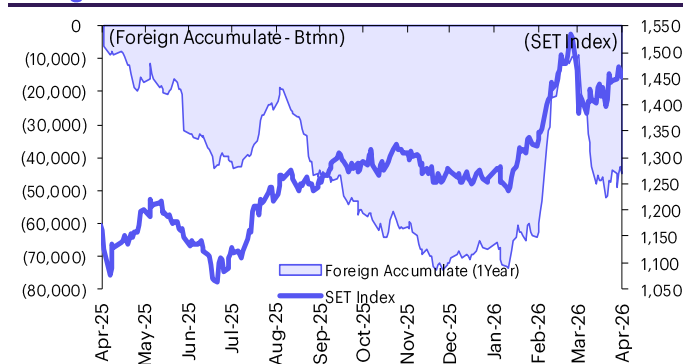

Thailand daily foreign net flows

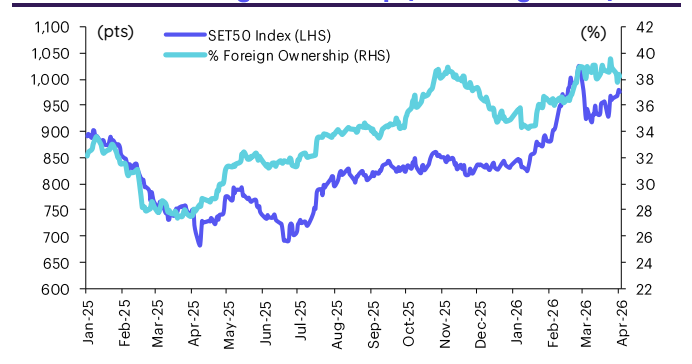

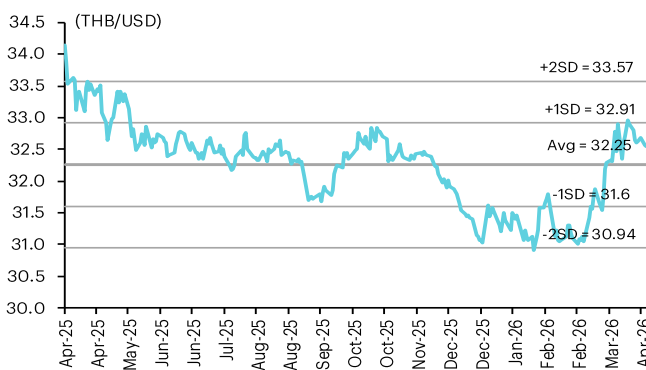
Thai and US 10-year government bond yield



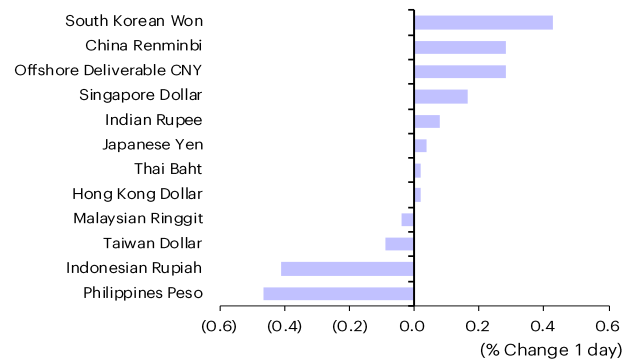
Thai and US 10-year government bond spread



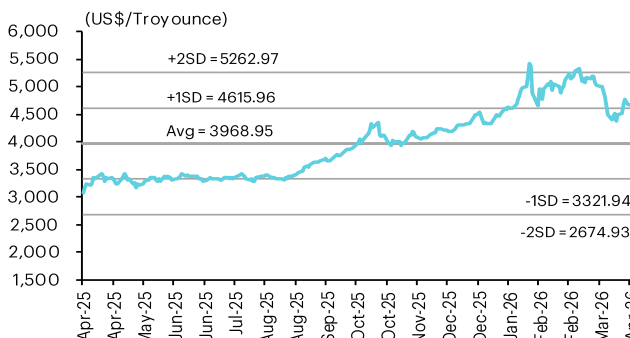
THB/USD exchange rate



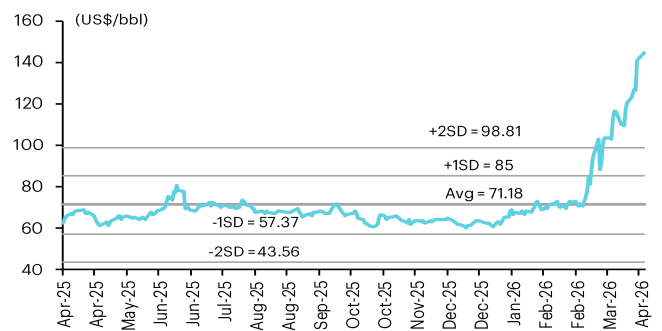
